Our Social Work Services for Pre-Primary Institutions

Our organisation was established in 1983 with the mission to care for the holistic development of young children and strengthen family systems. Since 2011, we have been providing on-site social worker/counsellor services to 6 of our affiliated nursery schools. In 2019, we were appointed by the Social Welfare Department to operate the "Pilot Scheme on Social Work Services for Pre-primary Institutions", serving 8 kindergartens/preschools. With the formal implementation of this service in 2024, our organisation was selected by the Social Welfare Department as the "District-based Social Work Team" for the Southern District of Hong Kong Island, providing stationed social work services to 18 pre-primary institutions.



#### Service Mission

With the spirit of Christ's love — spreading the Gospel, caring for the whole person, serving the community — we bring together professional knowledge and an open attitude to create a respectful and loving environment for young children, working hand-in-hand with parents to prepare them for optimal growth.

#### Service Objectives

- To facilitate early identification of pre-primary children and their families with welfare needs, and to provide timely assistance.
- To assist children facing challenges in learning, social skills, behaviour, or emotional well-being.
- To support parents in areas such as parenting and family relationships, fostering a harmonious family life.

Professional services include: individual counselling, consultation and referral services, group activities, workshops, staff training and crisis intervention, all delivered by school social workers.
